## Meeting Dr. Oren in Atlanta at the Airport July 7th, 2016

Please read everything on this page so you fully understand where we will meet at the airport

If you arrive into Atlanta early to visit friends/family (before July 7<sup>th</sup>), have them to drop you off at the Atlanta Hartsfield airport at the **International Terminal** on the ground floor. Go inside and find a seat. We will all be meeting here.

We will <u>ALL</u> meet on the lower level of the International Terminal. If you fly direct from Jamaica to Atlanta and go through customs in Atlanta, you will pick up your bags in the <u>International Terminal</u>. Once you have your bags, just walk out into the lower level. We will meet toward the back area.

If you go through customs in any other city and then have a connecting flight to Atlanta you will deplane at the **Domestic Terminal**. Once you secure your baggage in the Domestic Terminal you will have to follow the signs for **TRANSPORTATION**, which will take you outside the airport and you will catch a free shuttle over to the International Terminal at the Airport. The shuttle will drop you off at the lower level of the International terminal. Go in the doors and find us toward the back of the lower level. Large comfortable busses will take us to Campus (4 hours away).

AGAIN, I CANNOT STRESS ENOUGH THAT NO MATTER HOW YOU GET TO THE AIRPORT WE WILL BE MEEING ON THE **GROUND FLOOR** OF THE **INTERATIONAL TERMINAL**.

AGAIN, THERE IS A FREE SHUTTLE FROM THE DOMESTIC TERMINAL TO THE INTERNAITONAL TERMINAL

You will receive a packet in Atlanta with your room keys, class schedule, orientation packet, nametag AND STUDENT ID CARD. **DO NOT TAKE ANYONE ELSE'S PACKET. THE REMAINING PACKETS ARE HOW DR. OREN DETERMINES ARRIVALS.** If you take someone else's packet, they may be stranded in Atlanta.
