

GSA Executive Meeting 1/21/15

Attendance: Thom, Adam, Elizabeth, Paul, Leigh Ann

Travel Grants: 1 group from the MFA students, 1 group with individual details as well, and one individual person submitted for review. LOTS of discussion!

Multipack for Psychology groups for 4 people- plus 2 additional people who submitted separately to the same conference. We agreed to pay for the conference fee and milage for driving for both groups. \$70 for the conference fee plus \$52.89 for milage equals \$122.89 per person was approved. \$491.58 for the group of 4, and \$140 for conference fees for 2, and milage for 2 total \$105.14 (\$350.29 total).

For a grand total of \$841.87.

MFA group Approved \$1260 \$105 per person for lodging. (One person is getting lodging for free so he will receive \$105 toward the flight.)

Total \$1365 awarded to this group

Individual to attend conference in Athens, GA. Needs a hotel reservation confirmation receipt. Approved only \$70.80 for milage because receipt for lodging was not submitted.
