



DegreePlus Mentor Information (2023-2024)

Summary:

DegreePlus Mentors guide a student cohort through Level 2 (Integration & Application) and Level 3 (Articulation & Reflection)

Eligible:

Faculty and Exempt Staff

Paperwork:

Faculty complete a Policy 22 form for extra compensation.

EHRA staff are paid as a temporary worker and must receive authorization by supervisor.

Note: SHRA staff are not eligible for this position

Payment:

\$600 for one academic year paid over 9 payments.

Required Staff Meetings:

New DegreePlus Mentor Orientation

September and February Mentor Meetings

Mentees:

6-8 students who have completed Level 1.

Responsibilities:

The following responsibilities can be performed virtually or in person, as per current University guidelines.

- Connect with mentees who have been working on Skills Experiences over the summer.
- DegreePlus Day (once a semester)
 - Lead 6-8 mentees in a roundtable discussion about the DegreePlus events they attended
 - Review a case study and discuss how the DegreePlus skill applies
 - Guide students to work on a Plan of Action for Skills Experience that applies transferable skills.
- Level 2 Experience Plan
 - Review and approve Level 2 Plan of Action for Skills Experience via Canvas DegreePlus Course
 - Follow up as needed with student
- Poster Preparation
 - Meet with mentees in group or individually to discuss their posters for DegreePlus Day presentation
 - Please note: Students will receive a separate training on poster presentations from another professional
