 - Advertised at \$200 level eventually increasing to \$500
 - Awards ranged from \$125.00 to \$675.00
 - Awarded \$19,868.10
- Awarded 61 in FY 2021-22
 - Advertised at \$250 level for duration of FY
 - Awards ranged from \$125.00 to \$485.00
 - Awarded \$16,155.87
- Awarded to 41 different jurisdictions with 23 Counties represented

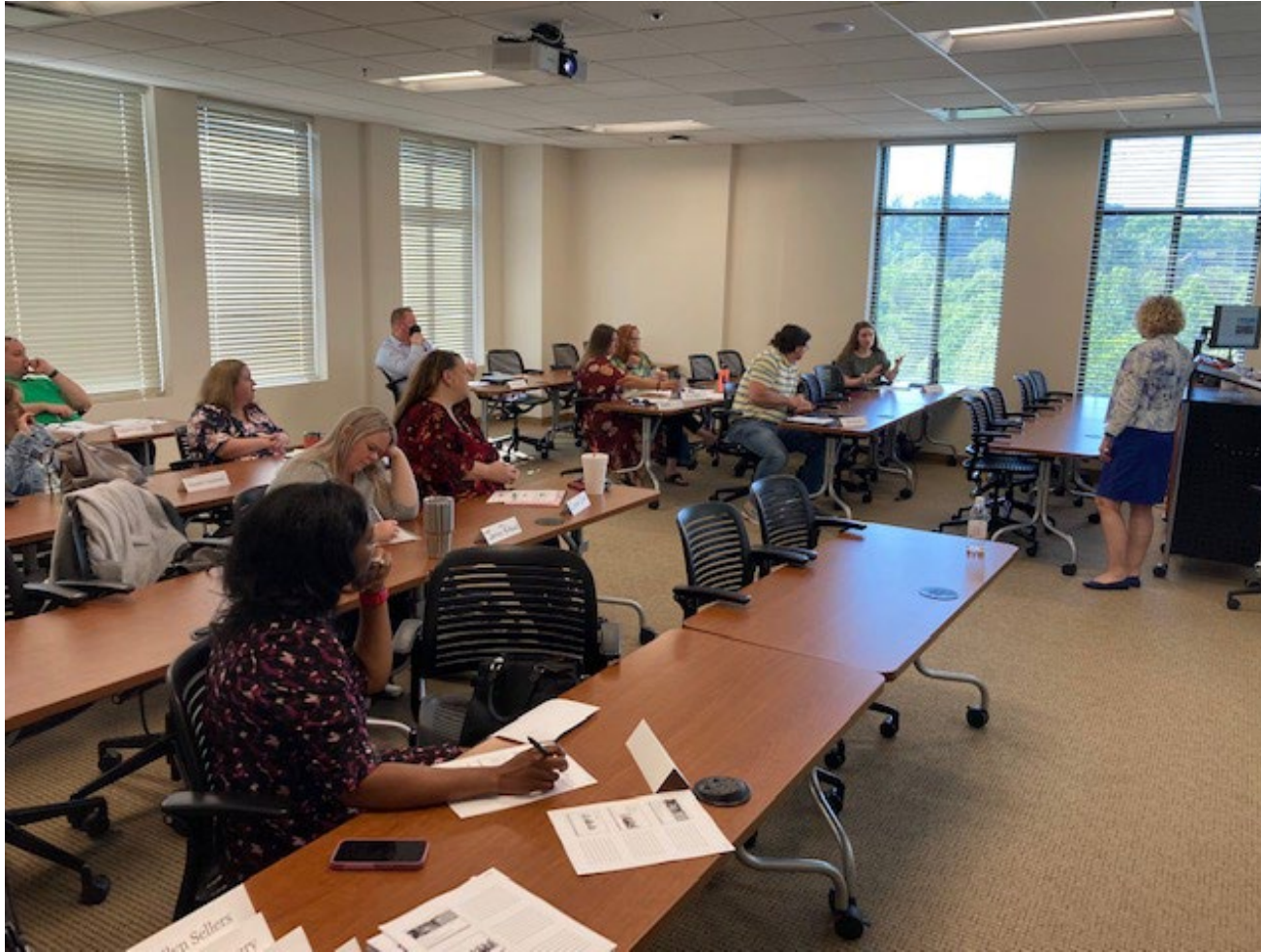
