**Dean's Report** Continuing to work on the action plan for Literacy. Our report (when it was due to us) was a

week late. Some of it was contrary to the initial report. Very challenging work. Plan is due May  $1^{st}$ , put it in action by July. Biltmore Park – new space has been acquired and everyone is very excited. We will have a voice, there will be a task force, more information to come. Kim and

Patricia have been handling the behind-the-scenes impact of compelled speech. This impacts many different areas from ongoing searches to graduate school applications. There is a lot of concern and a lot of issues. Provost has made sure no in-process applications were deleted. Several statements have been pulled out of the language that comes from our accreditation standards, NC Teaching standards, and laws on inclusion and diversity.

#### **UNC PiT Admissions\*\***

The numbers for fall are looking very good. Honor's College typically has about 300 - now at about 500. Another "Largest First Class". We've increased our number of out-of-state admits, but a decrease in graduate numbers. Kim will keep LC updated. Expect conversations in June/July about additional sections.
